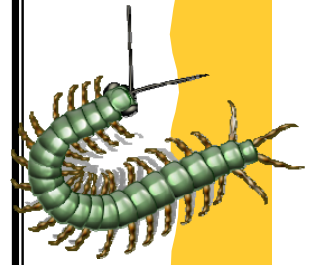
We will be collecting insects, putting together amateur collections, doing experiments with insects, learning how to properly identify insects, and learning how insects are important in our lives.

Participants will receive an insect collection kit (net, forceps, killing jar, pins, spreading boards, magnifier, booklet, pens, and collection box), perform experiments, and become junior entomologists.

If your child attended last year, they are welcome to come again—there will be a change in curriculum and experiments, so the material will be new and they can act as a mentor /counselor to new campers.
